

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Infants Program (Ages 6 wks-12 mos.)

Our infant teachers stimulate and challenge your baby by singing, talking, holding, and playing with him/her. The kinds of activities the teacher engages in with your child are carefully chosen each week to help him/her reach developmental milestones.

Toddler Program (Ages 1-2 yrs.)

Our toddlers are offered a variety of opportunities to explore their world through play. Gross motor skills and social skills are developed through both structured and unstructured play. Their days are filled with music, art, dance, story times and more.

Preschool (Ages 2-4)

Although it may seem like fun and games to preschoolers, the curriculum we follow is packed with educational elements. Games abound that teach pre-reading skills like phonemic awareness and letter and sound recognition; basic math concepts; French and Spanish; and hands-on science exploration.

Pre K (Private) (Ages 4-5)

Mirroring the state curriculum standards, the pre-kindergarteners focus on reading, early writing, and basic math. French and Spanish, science, social studies, art, music and physical education round out the learning. One field trip per quarter.

Elementary/After School (Ages 5-12)

School-age children are given a quiet environment for homework and projects, with supervised access to computers and tutoring/assistance as needed. Also available to elementary students are crafts, games, snacks and physical activities.

At Kids Come First ELC, your child will be involved in developmentally-appropriate activities throughout the day. Children will enjoy the playground-like atmosphere of our huge, fenced-in backyard, filled with age-appropriate activities. Preschoolers and school-age children will also enjoy learning in our state-of-the-art computer room.
